Alan Wayne Gammon, 43, of 13460 US Highway 29, Chatham, VA died Friday, October 11, 2013 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for one month.

Born July 19, 1970 in Elko, Nevada, he was the son of George Robert Gammon and the late Irene Francis Gammon.

Mr. Gammon lived in Reno, NV before moving to the Danville area in 1994.

He graduated from Dan River High School, class of 1988. He worked as a correctional officer at Green Rock Correctional Facility for eight years. He had been working in the prison system for the past ten years.

Alan loved helping everyone he could. He liked camping, shooting pool, going to the beach and spending time with his family and grandchildren.

In addition to his mother, he was predeceased by a sister, Jayne Amparo Hilton.

He is survived by his father, of Danville, VA; his fiancée, Faye Towler, of Chatham, VA; a brother, Robert Wade Gammon, and wife Teresa, of Danville, VA, a sister, Arlene G.
