Arthur Jones Louhoff, Jr., 78, of 154 Lawson Rd, Providence, NC, died on Mon. July 3, 2017 at his residence after being in declining health for the past 9 months.

Mr. Louhoff was born in Danville, VA on April 14, 1939, son of the late Arthur J. Louhoff and Vicie DeHart Louhoff.
