Barbara Ann Reynolds Hunt, 89, of Danville, VA, went Home to be with her Lord and Savior on Friday, March 5, 2021, at her residence, after a decline in health for the past two months.

Mrs. Hunt was born on February 15, 1932, a daughter of the late, step-father, Henry K. Ferrell, and the late Carrie Barbour Ferrell. She spent all of her life in the Danville area where she worked as a seamstress for the Gingerbread House from 1987 until 2000.
