June 27, 1944 - February 24, 2016

Barry Lamont Doss, age 71, of 3016 Westover Drive, Danville, VA, died on Wednesday February 24, 2016 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past three months.

Born on June 27, 1944, in Danville, VA, he was the son of the late Luther Gordon Doss and Helen Elizabeth Moore Doss. He lived most of his life in Danville, VA where he worked in sales. He attended Faith Memorial Baptist Church. Mr. Doss was a veteran of the U.S. Army and served at Tan Son Nhut Air Base in 1966 during the Vietnam Conflict.

On December 16, 1977 he married Ruby Fleenor Doss who survives.

In addition to his wife of the residence, he is survived by a daughter Kelly Dianne Doss of Chapel Hill, NC, and a brother, Rodney Doss (Pam) of Chatham, VA. Also surviving are sisters-in-law, Betty Burnette of Danville, VA and Peggy Sue Oakes (Robert) of Danville, VA, brother-in-law James Fleenor (Bonnie) of Bowie, MD, seven nieces, and four nephews.
