Benjamin Roger Sutton, age 66 of 3328 Rocksprings Road, Ringgold, VA died on Wednesday, November 25, 2015 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past three weeks.

Mr. Sutton was born in Macon, GA, on August 19, 1949, to the late Roger Sutton and Rebecca Hortman Sutton. He lived most of his life in Danville, VA. He served as a pastor for 23 years and later as a social worker at the Brian Center in Yanceyville, NC. Mr. Sutton was a member of The Tabernacle church.

On June, 10, 1972, he married Joan Kirby Sutton who survives of the residence. He was a man who loved the Lord and his family and was a very kind and forgiving man.
