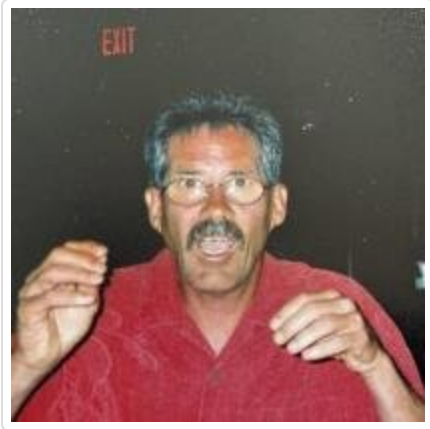




Bryan Lynn Jensen

June 27, 1957 - September 21, 2025

Bryan Lynn Jensen, 68, of Ringgold, VA, died Sunday, September 21, 2025 at his residence after a decline in his health for the past ten years.

Bryan was born in Everett, WA on June 27, 1957, a son of the late MSgt Glen Donald Jensen and Mildred Strader Jensen. He grew up in the Air Force living in Japan, Arizona, North Carolina and Myrtle Beach, SC. The family moved to Reidsville, NC and Bryan graduated from Wentworth High School, class of 1975 before entering the U.S. Navy for a short time. He eventually made it to Ringgold, VA, where he had been a resident for the last 30 years.

Bryan worked a variety of jobs during his life; worked on boilers, worked on golf courses, caddied on the pro golf tour, construction, The Gingerbread House in Danville, VA and finally in property maintenance at Purdum Woods Apartments in the Property Maintenance Department.

When asked about his favorite memories, Bryan reminisced about playing golf and being with his family. Bryan was an avid golfer.

He was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Navy.

On February 2, 1996, he married Nancy Hall Jensen, who survives.
