



## Charles Wallace Angle

Charles Wallace Angle, 83, of 209 Bel Aire Drive, Danville, VA, died Saturday, August 11, 2018 at SOVAH Health Danville after a decline in his health for the past year.

Wallace was born in the Spray community of Rockingham County, NC a son of the late Charles Ralph Angle and Delores Dillon Angle. He lived most of his life in the Schoolfield community of Danville. He retired from Old Dutch Supermarket on West Main Street as part owner and operator.
