Clarence T. Bartee, Jr., of 202 Alpine Dr. Danville, VA, died on Thursday, June 29, 2017,

at his residence after a decline in health for the past several months.

Mr. Bartee was born in Danville, VA, on December 14, 1927, son of the late Clarence T. Bartee, Sr. and the late Elsie Bartee Cox. He spent his entire life in the Danville area where he worked in the parts department of Swanson Motors until his retirement. He was a member of Kentuck Baptist Church where he served as church treasurer and as a deacon for many years. He was a veteran who proudly served his country in the United States Army.
