Doris Bennett Morris, one of God's precious angels was called home on Wednesday, January 29, 2014 at Danville Regional Medical Center. She had been in declining health for the past few months.

Doris was born in Pittsylvania Co, Virginia to Aubrey Branch Bennett and Pearl Collie Bennett on July 13, 1931. She lived most of her life in the Ringgold community except for brief periods in Florida and Alaska.

Doris was a graduate of Dan River High School and Averett College. She was a member of Kentuck Baptist Church.

Area sportsman would remember Mrs. Morris for cutting and fletching arrows for bow hunters in addition to repairing bows at Morris' store on 360. Doris also worked at Fuquay Pontiac and area banks. In her early years, Doris enjoyed camping and going to Myrtle Beach. She loved and cared for all living things – especially children, flowers, and animals.

Doris was predeceased by her parents, a brother, Roy Dudley Bennett, and her husband Edward Jackson Morris.
