Eunice Smith Mitchell, age 94, of 3636 Oak Hill Road, Danville, VA, died on Wednesday, April 13, 2016, at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past four months.

Mrs. Mitchell was born on October 10, 1921, in Pittsylvania County, VA, a daughter of the late James Thomas Smith and Mary Lillie Long Smith. She lived most of her life in the Ringgold community of Pittsylvania County and retired as a machine operator with Dan River Mills.
