Faye Harris Bradner, 75, of 247 Lansbury Drive, Danville, VA died Thursday, September 16, 2021 at her residence after being in declining health for the past nine years.

Faye was born in Danville, VA on October 7, 1945, a daughter of the late Virgil Harris and Chattie Lee Mahaffey Harris. She lived her entire life in Danville, VA and she retired from the Danville Public School System where she worked in the cafeteria.

Faye was of the Baptist faith. She enjoyed repairing and restoring porcelain dolls.

On June 19, 1964 she married Tyrone Lester Bradner, who survives.

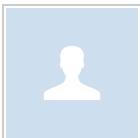
