Frances Carroll Coley Capps, 76, of Sutherlin, VA, went to her Heavenly home on Thursday, September 20, 2018 at SOVAH Health-Danville after a decline in health for the past few months.

Mrs. Capps was born in Rocky Mount, NC, on March 2, 1942, a daughter of the late Mabry Curtis Coley, Sr. and the late Nina "Tellie" Greene Coley. She lived part of her life in Rocky Mount, NC, before moving to the Sutherlin Community in 1984. She was a full time wife and mother who was devoted to caring for her children and grandchildren. She was a former member of Benvenue Baptist Church in Rocky Mount, NC. She was a current member of Laurel Grove Baptist Church. She was a mentor for Book Buddies at Kentuck Elementary School. 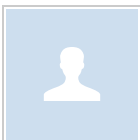
