



Hazel Geneva Reece Gammon

August 14, 1930 - September 16, 2018

Hazel Geneva Reece Gammon, 88, of Dry Fork, VA, died on Sunday, September 16, 2018 at SOVAH Health-Danville after a decline in health for the past few weeks.

Mrs. Gammon was born in Hickory, NC on August 14, 1930, a daughter of the late John Reece and the late Mattie Bonnie Reece. She lived part of her life in Florida before moving to Danville in the 1970s. She was retired from Dan River Mills where she worked in the weave room. In her spare time, she loved to cook and spend time with her children and grandchildren. She was a member of White Oak Worship Center where she served as Sunday school teacher and was a member of the choir and prayer lines.

She was married to Oliver Saunders Gammon, who died on December 28, 2006.

Survivors include a daughter, Patsy Allen (Donnie), of Blairs, VA; two sons, Carl Gammon, of Dry Fork, VA, and David Gammon, of Olney, TX; two sisters, Mildred Sullivan and Jean Niday; six grandchildren; seven great grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was predeceased by three sisters and three brothers.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, September 19, 2018 at 11:00 AM at White Oak Worship Center with Pastor Roger Ewing officiating. Interment will follow in Floral Hills Memory Gardens.
