Herbert Hodnett Guill, 89, of Brookdale Assisted Living, Danville, VA, died Sunday, July 30, 2017 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in his health for the past three years.

Mr. Guill was born in Pittsylvania County, VA, on January 22, 1928 a son of the late Willie Jefferson Guill, Sr. and Lottie Maye Hodnett Guill. He lived most of his life in the Mount Herman Community of Pittsylvania County.

He retired from the Virginia Department of Transportation as a Truck Driver. He was a member of Blairs Baptist Church. He was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Army in the Korean War.
