Ira Bracken Dameron, 85, of 5643 Park Springs Road, Pelham, NC went home to be with Lord on Saturday, February 27, 2016 after being in declining health for the past two years.

Mr. Dameron was born in Caswell County on March 4, 1930 a son to the late Ira Dameron and Helen Gatewood Dameron.
