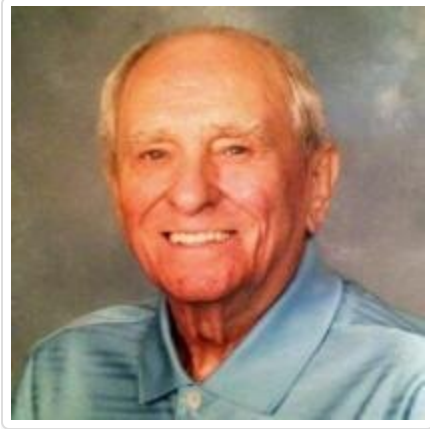




James Linwood Newcomb Sr
