James Fisher “Jim” Pruitt, Jr., 82, of Danville, VA went home to be with his Lord on Friday, February 21, 2025 at Sovah Health in Danville after being in declining health for several years.

Jim was born in Spartanburg, SC, on February 12, 1943, a son of the late James Fisher Pruitt, Sr. and Margaret Henson Pruitt. He spent the majority of his life in the Danville area, working as a route salesman for Frito-Lay before moving on to Little Debbie, where he retired. He took great pleasure in his work as a route salesman, building strong relationships with his customers, who admired him just as much. He attended Full Gospel Church and served in the National Guard for six years.

When his health permitted, he was an avid outdoorsman who loved hunting and fishing. A self-taught guitarist, he enjoyed playing music in his free time.

On April 2, 1966 he married Janet Reynolds Pruitt, who died on June 21, 2012.

Jim is survived by his sons, Brian David Pruitt and Timothy Allan Pruitt, both of Danville; brother, Jan Pruitt and his wife Donna; sister, Robin Martel and husband Chas; and his sister-in-law, Joan Reynolds.

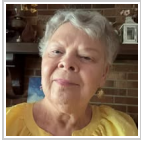
