Jan Norman Booker, 77, of 1176 Kent Street, Danville, VA died on Monday, July 14, 2025, at Duke University Hospital after a decline in health for the last 12 years.

Jan was born in Danville, VA on November 25, 1947, a son of the late Ray Jackson Booker and Evelyn Ludwick Booker. He was a proud graduate of George Washington High School, Class of 1966, and honorably served his country in the United States Navy. Following his military service, he began his professional career as a cost accountant with Commodore Mobile Homes before continuing his work as a purchasing agent for the Danville City Housing Authority.

Jan was a faithful member of Moffett Memorial Baptist Church where he served as a deacon. He had a deep love for horses—riding them in his younger years and later caring for many alongside his wife. He also enjoyed building and working with his hands.
