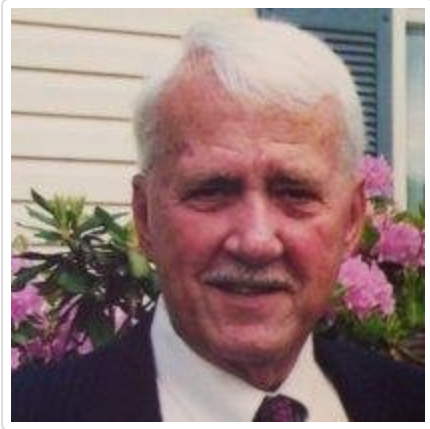




John Edward Powers
