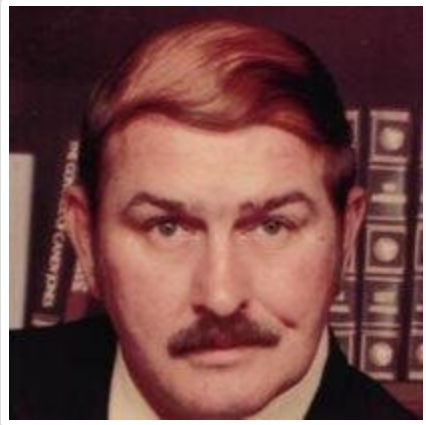




Kenneth Erwin Stevens
