



Lance Byrd Gravely

November 2, 1919 - December 29, 2012

Lance Byrd Gravely, 93, of 159 West Woodlawn Drive, Danville, VA died on Saturday, December 29, 2012 at the V.A. Hospital in Durham, NC after a decline in health for the past five years.

Mr. Gravely was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on November 2, 1919 a son of the late Lewis Gravely, Sr. and the late Nena Byrd Gravely. He spent most of his life in the Danville area where he worked at Dan River Mills until his retirement. He was a veteran of World War II serving in the US Army. He was a member of Fairview United Methodist Church.

Mr. Gravely was married to Lucille B. Gravely who survives of the residence.

In addition to his wife he is survived by one step daughter, Laverne Saunders of Centerville, VA; one brother Lewis Gravely, Jr. and one sister, Jean Gravely Fowler both of Danville, VA.
