September 29, 1941 - February 27, 2024

Walter Leon Wiles, 82, of 2385 Kerns Church Road, Sutherlin, VA went home to be with his Lord on Tuesday, February 27, 2024 after a courageous battle with cancer.

Leon was born in Danville, VA on September 29, 1941, and was one of three children born to the late Thomas Wiles and Mary Blankenship Wiles. He was predeceased by his parents as well as his beloved brother, Carroll Wayne Wiles; and his beloved sister, Lelia Ann W. Owens.

Leon met his wife Connie Hines Wiles at a young age, and they got married on August 17, 1963. Together they raised two children, Teresa Wiles Ricketts (Bryan) and Walter Robert Wiles (Tracey).

On their farm they were blessed to watch their family grow to include nine grandchildren and ten great grandchildren.

He spent all of his life in the Sutherlin Community of Pittsylvania County where he retired from Dan River Mills after 45 years of service and then went on to enjoy several years working for Cloverdale Lumber. He gave his all to each job he had, but will be remembered most for the way he spent his life tending to the things he loved the most: his family, his friends, and his farm. He will be greatly missed, not only by his family but by the community as a

whole.

A graveside service will be conducted on Friday, March 1, 2024 at 1:00 P.M. at the Wiles Family Farm Cemetery with the Mr. Lee Ricketts officiating.

The family will receive friends on Thursday evening from 6:00 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel and at other times the family will be at the residence, 2385 Kerns Church Road, Sutherlin, VA 24594.

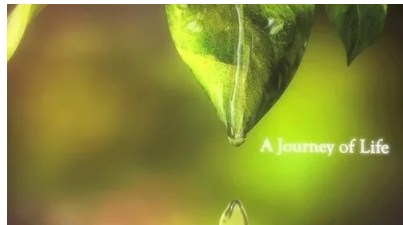
