Lewis Gravely, Jr., 97, of Danville went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Wednesday, April 19, 2023.

Born in Danville, VA on February 22, 1926 he was a son of the late Lewis Gravely, Sr. and Nena Ruth Byrd Gravely.

Lewis proudly served his country in the US Army and was at the Battle of the Bulge during WWII. He retired in 1990 from the Register & Bee Publishing Company.

He loved his Lord, his family, and his country. He was an active member of Schoolfield Baptist Church where he was a deacon and choir member. He went on mission trips to Costa Rica and also worked with World Changers. He was an active member of the Redmen, the American legion Dan River Post 1097, DAV Chapter 19 and the YMCA.

He enjoyed gardening, wood working, camping, fishing, and to eat at Cracker Barrel.

On January 20, 1950 he married Pauline Elizabeth Lewis Gravely, who passed away in 2004.

Survivors include a daughter, Carol G. Coleman (Dennis), six grandchildren, eleven great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren.

In addition to his wife he was predeceased by a daughter, Cathy Congdon, two sisters, June Simpson, Jean Fowler and two brothers, Lance and Basil Gravely.
