January 11, 1925 - December 10, 2014

Lula Belle Baker Moss, 89, of 3221 Vandola Road, Danville, Virginia, died Wednesday, December 10, 2014 at Riverside Health and Rehabilitation Center after being in declining health for several months.

Mrs. Moss was born on January 11, 1925 in White County, Georgia; the daughter of the late Robert Lester Baker and the late Anna Myrtle Edwards Baker.

In August, 1943, she moved to Danville to work at Dan River, Inc. where she was proudly employed until her retirement in 1987. Shortly after her employment, she was introduced to Edward Lee Moss by a co-worker (Lee's mother), while Lee was on furlough from the U.S. Army. They corresponded during his deployment to Germany. Upon Lee's discharge they were married on September 21, 1946 until his death on December 31, 2006. She was also predeceased by a grandson, Anderson Lee Moss; two brothers, Frank and James Baker and a sister Ruth B. Hopkins

Mrs. Moss was a member of Southhall/Westover Baptist Church from 1943 until present. She taught the Junior Girls Sunday School Class. She enjoyed quilting, reading and working large jigsaw puzzles.

She is survived by a son, Alvin L. Moss and wife Jean of Danville; brothers, Buford and Corbett Baker of Cleveland, Georgia; sisters, Fannie Mae Baker of Cleveland, Georgia, and Ellen B. Gunnells of Danville; grandchildren, Jonathan P. Moss (wife Sarah) and Jessica M. Glasscock (husband Clifton) of Danville and four great-grandchildren, Sadie Rae, Nash Alexander and Josie Belle Glasscock and Reagan Olivia Moss.
