Michael Odell Dowell, 68, of 150 Lamberth Drive, Danville, died on Sunday October 25, 2020 at Sovah Health after being in declining health for the past two weeks.

Mr. Dowell was born in Danville, VA on May 12, 1952, a son of the late Cecil Odell Dowell and Arilda “Granny Sally” Celestine Jones Dowell. Mr. Dowell proudly served in the United States Army for over 20 years, and retired at rank of First Sergeant. He went on to work as a guidance counselor at Southside Elementary School where he shaped thousands of young minds. He ended his career as a mental health counselor at Piedmont Mental Health Services. He was of the Baptist faith and was involved with the Wounded Warrior Project. Mr. Dowell was an avid collector of muscle cars and enjoyed spending time with friends and family.

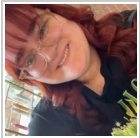
