January 29, 1949 - October 3, 2017

Michael Irvin Meadows, 68, of 5365 Kentuck Road Ringgold, passed away on Tuesday, October 3, 2017 at SOVAH Health, in Danville after being hospitalized for the past four days.

Mike was born in Suffolk, VA on January 29, 1949, a son of the late Irvin Fultz Meadows and the late Monica Heawood Meadows. Mike had lived most of his life in the Kentuck Community of Pittsylvania County. He had worked as a Brick Mason for himself prior to becoming employed by the Corning Glass Works where he continued to work as a brick and block mason until his retirement. Mike attended Williamson Memorial Presbyterian Church. He served with the U.S. Marines Corps in Viet Nam where he was a Purple Heart recipient and he also served with the Virginia Army National Guard. Mike was a lifetime member of the DAV and a member of the Ballard Pruitt, VFW Post 647.

On December 12, 1969 he married, Becky Gibson Meadows, who survives of the residence.

Survivors also include two sons, Brian Meadows, and Chris Meadows, and wife, Carrie; both of Ringgold; two brothers, Donald Meadows, and wife, Bonnie, of Kintersville, PA, Ricky Meadows, and wife, Janet, of Ringgold, one sister, Veronica M. Ashworth, of Myrtle Beach, SC, four grandchildren,

Kimmie, Kelsey, Kendall, and Cayleigh Meadows, and his faithful companion, Dude.

Mike was predeceased by his parents, one son, Michael Irvin Meadows, Jr.; a grandson, Christopher Michael Meadows; and a sister, Cynthia Meadows.

Funeral services for Mike will be on Saturday, October 7, 2017 at 11:00 AM at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel conducted by the Rev. Dr. Robert Ramey. Interment will follow in Floral Hills Memory Gardens with Military Honors conducted by the U.S. Marines Honor Guard. The family will receive friends at the residence.

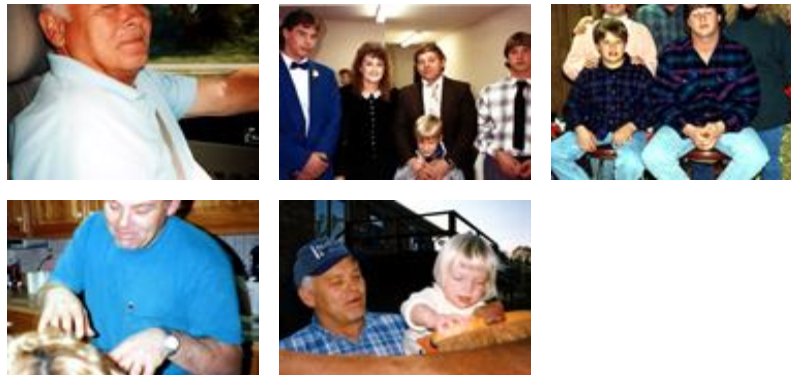
