Mildred Gilbert DeHart, 91, of 9937 Martinsville Hwy, died Tuesday, November 8, 2011 at Danville Regional Medical Center.

Mrs. DeHart was born on March 3, 1920, in Patrick County, the daughter of the late Clee O. Gilbert and Mary Ida Handy Gilbert.

She worked as a clerk in the Dan River cloth store. She was a faithful member of Sharon Baptist Church, where she was past president of the Ruth Bible class. She was a member of the Dan River Retirees and Senior Citizen's Club.
