Nancy McAlister Motley Haden, age 81, of 138 Charlestowne Drive, Danville, VA went home to be with her Lord on Thursday, February 28, 2013 after being in declining health for the past two years.

Born February 22, 1932 in Ruffin, North Carolina, she was a daughter of the late James McAlister and Maggie Meador McAlister. She lived all of her life in Danville, VA and retired from the City of Danville as Chief Deputy Commissioner of Revenue. She was a member of Rivermont Baptist Church where she had served as a Sunday School Teacher. She was a member of Gideon's International and she served as a volunteer at Danville Regional Medical Center.

On March 26, 1955 she married Hughes Motley who died on August 25, 1984. She was married to Norris Haden on June 13, 1987, he died August 26, 2004. Survivors include a son, Jimmy Motley, and wife Fran, of Danville, VA; a granddaughter, Lindsey Kreger; a brother, Jimmy McAlister, of Christiansburg, VA; two sisters-in-law, Annie Laurie Willis and Marilyn Snead; several nieces and nephews; her loving and devoted caregivers, Willie Woods and Theresa Terry; and her close friend, Betty Sartin.
