January 16, 1966 - May 15, 2023

Regina Lynn Scarce Lynskey, 57, of Pelham, NC, died Monday, May 15, 2023 at Annie Penn Hospital in Reidsville, NC after a decline in her health for the past year.

Regina was born in San Antonio, TX on January 16, 1966, a daughter of the late Daniel Clarence Scarce and Brunhilde Swhmalzl Scarce. She lived most of her life in Danville, VA before moving to Pelham, NC in 2005.

Regina worked as a Registered Nurse at Roman Eagle Rehab and Health Care Center. She was a member of Westover Baptist Church.

On May 21, 2005 she was married to Alan Ray Lynskey, who survives.

In addition to her husband, of Pelham, NC, and her mother, of Danville, VA, Regina is survived by a brother Paul Scarce (Polly) of Blairs, VA.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, May 19, 2023 at 4:00 P.M. at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with Dr. Lance Roberts officiating. The family will receive friends on Friday, at the funeral home, from 3:00 until 4:00 P.M.

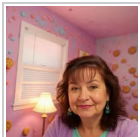
