Shiryl Robert “Robbie” Bateman, 68, of 2081 Oak Hill Road, Danville, VA passed away on Monday, January 29, 2024 at his residence after being in declining health for the last year.

Robbie was born on June 11, 1955 a son of the late Bobby Bateman and Nancy Gaynell Farthing Bateman. He spent all of his life in the Danville area where he worked for the Virginia State Highway Department as a supervisor for 34 years until his retirement.

In his spare time Robbie enjoyed traveling to the mountains, hunting and fishing. He was a member of Harmony United Methodist Church.

On August 21, 1976 he married, Cathy Scott Bateman who survives of the residence.
