Robert O. Byrd, Jr., 78 years old, being held by the hands and hearts of his family was released to the hands of Jesus Christ, Sunday, Nov. 9th, 2014.

Born in Danville, VA on August 10, 1936, he was the son of the late Robert O. Byrd, Sr., and Lula Merricks Byrd. He was predeceased by two sisters, Louise B. High, Christine B. Willis.

On August 25, 1956 he married Julia Nuckols Byrd, who survives of the residence. Their 58 year union was blessed by five strong children. Through the ups and downs of life, Mr. Byrd was ever devoted to his wife and family; willing to help in times of crises; willing to laugh in times of joy; willing to council in times of confusion; and willing to offer thankful prayers no matter the circumstances.

Survivors include a son, R. Wayne Byrd, of Ringgold; four daughters, Vickie D. Booth, and husband, Larry, of Jonesboro, GA; Phyllis B. Brown, of Danville; Lisa B. Barker, of Charlotte, NC; Lori B. Grubbs, and husband, Christopher, of Richmond, VA; a sister, Mae Abram, of Erie, PA; ten grandchildren, and one great-grandchild.

Mr. Byrd worked as a Heavy Equipment Supervisor for APAC Virginia. He was a member of Third Avenue Congregational Christian Church and was active in

the “young-at-hearts” fellowship group in the church. He was an avid fisherman, always willing to accompany others on trips to the water. His companionship and sage advice, offered with a willing smile over the top of a bent fishing pole will be sorely missed.

Mr. Byrd also loved working with computers and helping other seniors to master the machines. He kept in touch via email and loved doing research on many topics, foremost of which was the history of families. Mr. Byrd worked with the Virginia-North Carolina Genealogical Society where he spent many hours helping family, friends, and community members in tracing their heritage. He also served as Treasurer for the Society.

Mr. Byrd was a story-teller in the grand tradition of the south. He could spin a yarn, swap stories, and recite historical events. He could not be topped, always having more to add with a wink and a smile.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, November 13th at 11:00 AM at the Third Avenue Congregational Christian Church. Services will be conducted by the Rev. Frederick J. Vicks. Interment at the Danville Memorial Gardens will be private.

The family will receive friends on Wednesday, November 12th from 7:00-8:30 PM at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel.
