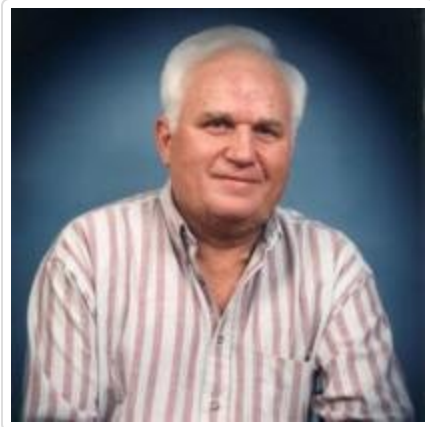




Roger Earl Parrish

May 19, 1944 - April 2, 2021

Roger Earl Parrish, 76, of Danville, passed away on April 2, 2021 at his residence that he loved after a courageous battle with kidney disease. Roger was born in Guilford County, NC on May 19, 1944, a son of the late Kemp Wayne Parrish and Oletha Brown Parrish. He spent his childhood in Hampton, VA close to the beach that he loved. He came to Danville to attend DTI where he met the love of his life Judy, his wife of 54 years.
