



Seldon "Wayne" Freeman

Seldon "Wayne" Freeman, 87, of 645 Gemstone Lane, Danville, VA died on Wednesday, March 4, 2026 at SOVAH Health Danville after a two year decline in health.

Wayne was born in Danville on November 10, 1938 to the late Fred Lee Freeman and Mollie Pyron Freeman.

On March 18, 1957, Wayne married Claudine Gill Freeman, who preceded him in death on January 19, 2010.

Wayne spent his entire life in Danville, first running S.W. Freeman Contracting, and later working as a truck driver until his retirement. He was a member of Hillcrest Baptist Church.
