Stuart Wayne Taylor, 67, of Axton, went home to be with his Lord on Monday, November 10, 2025, at Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital.

Born in Danville on May 17, 1958, he was the son of the late Henry Clay Taylor and Iva Walker Taylor. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Steve C. Taylor.

On August 6, 1983, Stuart married the love of his life, Lisa Moore Taylor, who survives him, along with their two children, Zachary W. Taylor (Rebekah) of Arkansas and Morgan B. Harris (Ethan) of Danville; one granddaughter, Amelia James Harris; and his beloved grand-dog, Rocket Taylor.

As a self-employed excavator, Stuart built a reputation for precision and skill, proudly maintaining his business for 41 years.

Stuart had a lifelong passion for speed and competition, beginning with motocross and dirt late model stock and modified car racing. Later in life he loved spending time on his motorcycle and was an active member of the Patriot Guard Riders and leading others on scenic rides. Stuart also enjoyed camping and fishing, finding peace and joy in the great outdoors.

Above all, he was a devoted member of White Oak Worship Center, where he

faithfully served and found strength in his faith and community.
