Teresa Harris Haraway, 79, of Danville passed away on Monday, January 8, 2024 after a brief illness.

Born in Seymour, IN on December 26, 1944 a daughter of the late Grover Cecil and Mary Wingfield Harris.

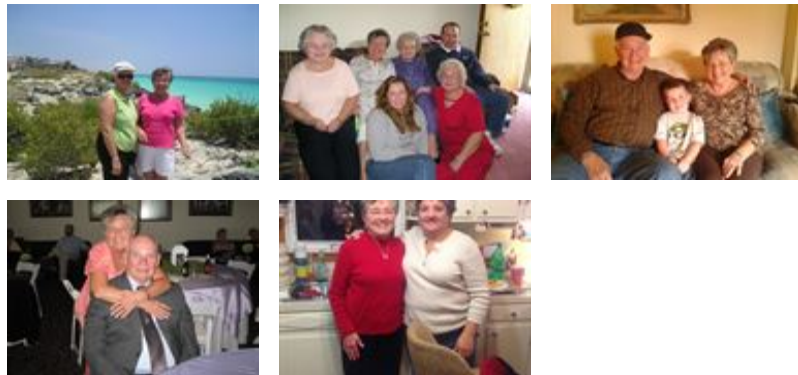
