November 9, 1940 - July 21, 2014

Verbie Irene Simmons Jordan, 73, of 2840 Ringgold Depot Road, Lot 47, Sutherlin, VA, died Monday, July 21, 2014 at Roanoke Memorial Hospital after being in declining health for the past two years and in the hospital since June 10, 2014.

Born in Sampson County, North Carolina on November 9, 1940, she was a daughter of the late Ralph Edward Simmons and Edna Earle Hood Simmons.
