July 7, 1928 - April 10, 2013

Violet Riddle Smith, 84, of 221 Swain Drive Danville, Virginia died Wednesday, April 10, 2013 at Wesley Long Hospital in Greensboro, NC.

She was born July 7, 1928 in the Java community of Pittsylvania County a daughter of Walter Riddle and Pearl Terry Riddle. Mrs. Smith had lived her entire life in the Danville area and had worked for Dan River Mills and later was the owner and operator of restaurants in Danville and Chatham.

She was a member of Moffett Memorial Baptist Church where she had taught Sunday school and was a leader for youth activities. Mrs. Smith devoted her entire life to her family.

On July 31, 1948 she was married to Frank Wilbert Smith, who died December 14, 2005.

Survivors include two daughters, Ann S. Wilson and husband, Randy of Winston-Salem, NC and Lisa S. Rowland and husband, Cecil of Cary, NC; four grandchildren, Leslie W. Miller, Lindsey W. Paul, Brittany Rowland and Liz Rowland; a special niece, Polly Fromm and her husband Jim and their children, Jay and Chris.

She was the last survivor of her generation and was preceded in death by

brothers, Lynn, Brantley, Harvey, Walter and Lonnie Riddle and sisters, Elizabeth Dix and Janie Riddle.
