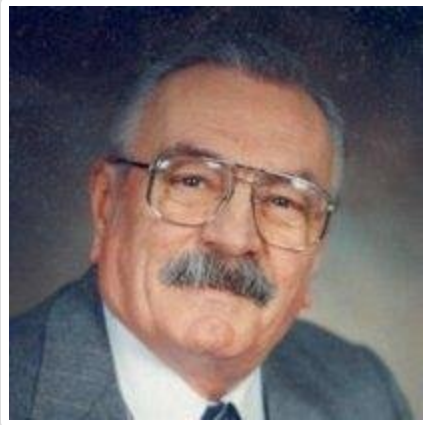




Warner Lee Hudson

Warner Lee Hudson, age 78, of 210 Lamberth Drive, Danville, VA died Saturday, March 9, 2013 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for the past six months.

Mr. Hudson was born in Alton, VA on June 11, 1934 a son of the late Joseph Clifton Hudson and Nettie Foster Hudson. He lived his early years in Halifax County where he attended Turbeville High School, and had lived most of his life in Danville, VA. He retired from Hemingway Trucking Company where he had worked as a truck driver. He was of the methodist faith and loved working in his yard.
