Wayne Lawrence, 82, of 219 Greenwich Circle, Danville, Va., died on Thursday, July 16, 2015, after being in declining health for the past several months.

Mr. Lawrence was born in the Callands Community of Pittsylvania County on June 19, 1933, a son of the late James Lawrence and Abbie Adkins Lawrence. He had lived all of his life in Pittsylvania County and Danville. Mr. Lawrence had retired from the former Dan River Inc. after 47 years of service.
