



Willard Browning Armstrong

November 15, 1926 - July 25, 2014

Willard Browning Armstrong, 87, of 304 Hickory Forest Rd Danville died Friday, July 25, 2014 at Piney Forest Health & Rehab Center after a decline in health for the past year.

Born in Augusta County, VA on November 15, 1926 a son of the late Arlie Bryan Armstrong and Virginia Armstrong.

Mr. Armstrong served in the U.S. Navy during WWII where he was on the USS Anzio Aircraft Carrier. He worked as a Loom Fixer. He was a member of Shermont Baptist Church and the Royal Gems Retirees Club, and the former Westover Volunteer Fire Department.

On October 28, 1948, he married Betty Lyons Armstrong who died on June 16, 2002.
