William Joseph Setliff, 76, of Danville passed away on Friday, July 12, 2024 after a decline in health for the past two years.

Born in Danville, VA on April 25, 1948 he was a son of the late Willie Joe Setliff, Jr., and Euna Jefferson Setliff.

Joe served in the US Army including a tour of duty in Vietnam. He retired as a Partner and CPA from Dixon Hughes Goodman. He was a member of Hillcrest Baptist Church.
