Willis B. Keatts, 73, of the Brosville Community died Friday, April 10, 2015 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past three months.

Mr. Keatts was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on April 20, 1941 a son of the late Horace Eugene Keatts and Pearl Barber Keatts.

Mr. Keatts worked for Goodyear Tire & Rubber. He was a very active member of Hillcrest Baptist Church for over 52 years where he served as a Deacon, was in charge of maintenance for the church vans and buses, served on the Nominating Committee, the counting Committee and various other positions in his church.
