Harry Winston Aron, 81, of Danville, Virginia, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Friday, May 8, 2026, at Stratford Rehabilitation and Healthcare Center.

Winston was born in Danville, Virginia, on January 30, 1945, to the late Oliver Witcher Aron and Ruth Allen Aron Shelton.

A graduate of Virginia Tech with a degree in Mechanical Engineering, Winston began his career with General Electric and later served as Purchasing Manager for Disston Company. Possessing a true entrepreneurial spirit, he went on to own AMS Sales, where he worked for many years as a manufacturer's representative.

Winston's greatest passion, however, was buying and selling antiques and collectibles. He delighted in sharing stories of his unique discoveries and treasured finds.
